A. *I now want to go through with the pregnancy.*

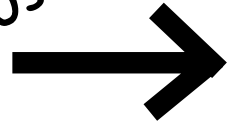
Q. How do you feel about your total experience at the Center?

As I came to Crossroads and saw the number of young, uneducated girls coming into the center in need of our services, my heart was broken. We have got to tell them what our God says about the sanctity of marriage and the blessings in “waiting”. I opened up to a fellow trainee, Jennifer Adams, who had felt the same tug on her heart to raise awareness in our community about such topics and to share the Word of God with our youth. Momentum was born! Senitra Syas, a fellow volunteer, came on board the team only a short time later.

Eight months later, on January 23-24, Momentum youth worship service took place in Magnolia Ballroom. It was a great time of fun, fellowship, worship, and commitment from attendees to commit themselves to a life of purity, abstinence and from substance abuse.
